

SALT/PEPPER SHAKER

A CUSTOM DESIGN MADE BY JERRY D. PLANT, FROM ICE CREAM STICKS, STRIPS OF ALUMINUM FROM SODA POP CANS, AND HOT GLUE SCAVAGED FROM PASTERY BOXES. THE PLUGS AND PINS WERE HAND CARVED FROM WOOD, BUT I DON'T KNOW THE SOURCES.

THIS WAS A SUPERB SHAKER AS IT WAS EASY TO USE, EASY TO FILL, AND HELD A BIG SUPPLY OF SALT AND PEPPER CONTAINED IN A SINGLE CONTAINER. THE ONE DRAWBACK THOUGH WAS THE HOT GLUE HOLDING EVERYTHING TOGETHER, AS AFTER SEVERAL MONTHS USE SOME OF THE METAL FITTINGS WOULD LET GO.
